But now a report from an unlikely source suggests otherwise. A sobering new study of Britain's youth reveals that as many as 43% are not online at all—that they have no Internet connection. The report, from the Royal Society for Public Health, documents the dismal state of British youth, who are the worst off when it comes to the tools of the digital revolution. "Policymakers and planners need to act urgently to address this public health crisis and improve educational attainment among Britain's young people," the report warns. The cause, they conclude, is heavy use of mobile phones, with young people facing constant "electronic noise" and "social isolation." "Worrying as the study findings are, there is good news," says Kathryn Wynnyk, professor of health psychology at the University of Sussex. "The study indicates that we can begin to address some of these issues." The study, conducted in 2011, surveyed over 12,000 10- to 19-year-olds—about 20% of whom are not on the Internet, according to the report. Based on the survey, it found that girls are much less likely to use the Internet than boys. The study's authors point to a host of reasons—for example, girls tend to have better language skills and a more complex social network—but it's an unfortunate fact that girls in the UK, like in many countries, are "significantly less likely to be active Internet users than boys."
